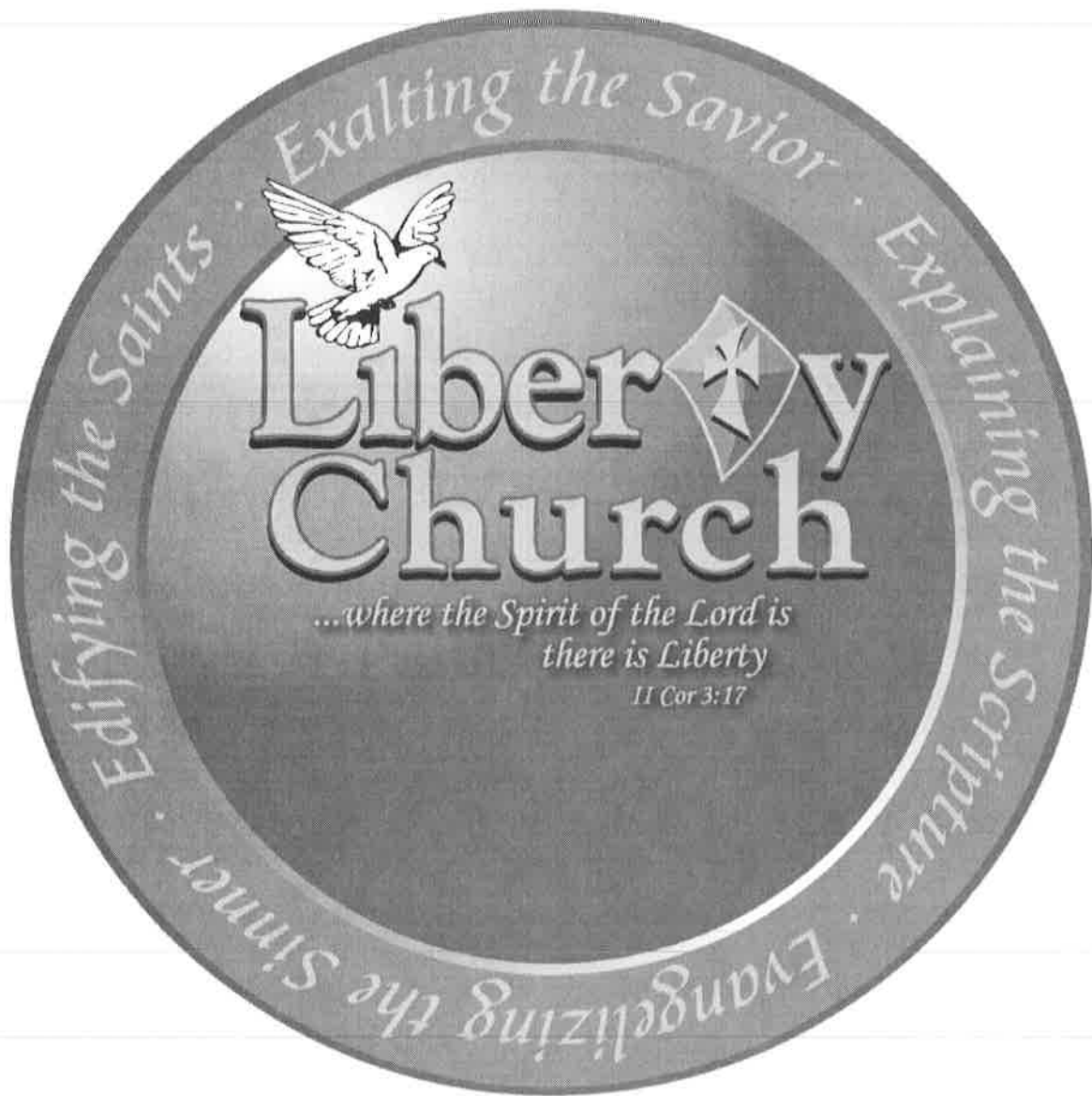


The Liberty Church 2020 Scholarship Packet

- ___ Student must have at least a 2.75 Cumulative Grade Point Average
- ___ An "Official" school transcript w/seal must be submitted with the completed application
- ___ Two letters of recommendation (one from school personnel and one from someone in the community); strongly recommend use of letterhead
- ___ 500-word essay (Typed, 12 point font, Times New Roman, double-spaced) along with application
- ___ If you have applied and have been accepted to a two- or four-year college or university, please attach your acceptance letter with this application.
- ___ Official ACT/SAT scores (optional)
