The Greater Clarksville National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC) is now accepting applications for our 2020-2021 NPHC Scholarships. Our scholarships are available to qualifying high school seniors enrolled in the Clarksville-Montgomery County School System who plan to continue their education after graduation.

The 2020-2021 NPHC scholarships will be awarded to first-place **(\$750.00)**, second-place **(\$500.00)**, third-place **(\$250)** winners. The scholarship committee will thoroughly review each application packet received to determine the first and second-place winners. Notification will be sent to the winners via mail no later than April 1, 2020. The scholarships will be made payable to the respective university or college in the recipient's name upon receipt of enrollment verification.

The following items are required by March 15, 2020 in order to be considered for our 2020-2021 NPHC Scholarships:

- Completed Scholarship Application
- 1-2 Page Essay on the topic "Does any attribute, quality, or skill distinguish you from everyone else? How did you develop this attribute?")
- 2 Letters of Recommendation- One must be from the applicant's school administrators, faculty, or guidance counselor. The other can be from a friend or member of the community.
- Official Transcripts- student MUST have an overall 3.0 GPA or higher
