Landon Dunn Memorial Student-Athlete Scholarship

In 2015, a Montgomery Central High School Student-Athlete will receive this scholarship. It will be a one time \$500 award given with entry into the student's school of choice. Every year, a student-athlete will be awarded this scholarship. The recipient can be any student-athlete who graduates from Montgomery Central High School and has excelled in athletics and in the classroom.

The scholarship is given in honor of Landon Dunn who passed away in 2013. Landon was a 1958 graduate of MCHS. He was a dedicated husband, father, and supporter of academics and athletics. He was married for fifty-three years to Joyce Richardson Dunn. All five of their children graduated from and played sports for Montgomery Central High School. Upon graduating MCHS, they all obtained college degrees.

Landon and Joyce always stressed the importance of education, and they instilled this belief in their children. They also volunteered in a variety of school activities throughout their lives. Landon served as President of the PTA, and Joyce volunteered numerous times to go on field trips and to work in the nurse's office.

They were also both heavily involved in athletics at Montgomery Central. Landon coached little league baseball and softball for over twenty years. He won numerous District 9 championships, and his 1984 baseball team and 1988 softball team won state championships. Many of the players who won the baseball state championship played for MCHS on Coach Todd Dunn's first team in 1986. He served as the president of the MCHS Booster Club for several years. Landon was also instrumental in building the baseball field that the team currently plays on. Joyce also coached numerous softball teams and was an avid fan of all sports at Montgomery Central.
